## **Job Description**

#### **GENERAL PURPOSE:**

The Water Safety Instructor will teach swimming and water safety skills to patrons utilizing the indoor aquatic facility located at the Excelsior Springs Community Center.

### **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Be familiar with American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim levels and other Red Cross water safety courses and know how to use course materials effectively
- Adapt your teaching approaches to the age, experience and ability of participants so they can meet course objective
- Cover all material required in a level of the American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim program
- Prevent accidents and eliminate or minimize hazardous situations
- Respond quickly to all emergency situations and administer first aid as needed
- Observe and enforce all rules and regulations of the facility
- Educate and inform patrons of the rules and regulations of the facility
- Communicate regularly with participants and their parents, as appropriate, to ensure they are aware of progress
- Present professional appearance and attitude at all times and maintain a high standard of customer service
- Attend all in-service training sessions and additional staff meetings
- Maintain job-related skills at a high level
- Complete all required reports and records in a timely fashion and submit them to Aquatics Supervisor and/or Assistant Aquatics Supervisor
- Maintain a clean, safe, and sanitary facility x Perform all other related duties as assigned
